When you visit the www you will be able to view this Newsletter along with lots of other relevant information, including A Disclaimer, and A Constitution which outlines our roles and responsibilities

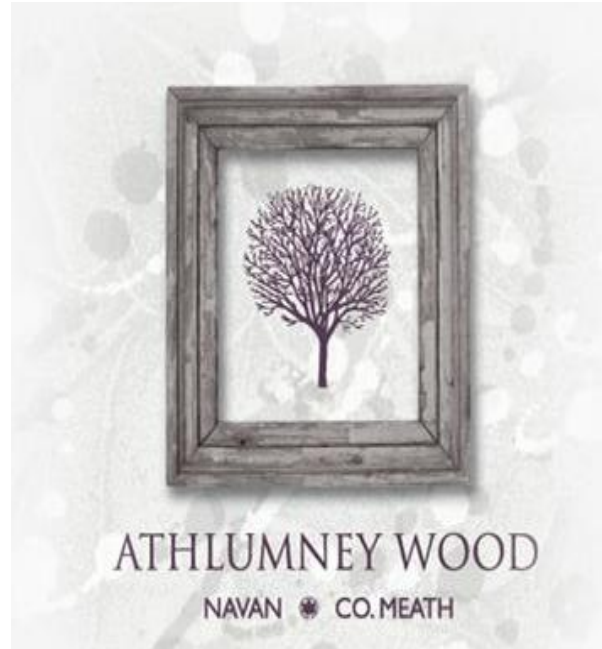
