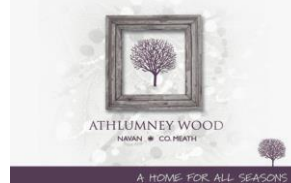
This forum is for local residents to highlight any anti-social behaviour, alerts for local criminal activity, notices of interest which may affect residents positively or negatively.

If you can afford to pay the €30 in one payment it would be appreciated, but we will accept instalments. These funds are vital for the maintenance of the estate, specifically grass cutting. The Council do NOT cut the grass.
