Grass cutting will commence shortly for 2018. The contractor is cutting only the main green areas, so it's your responsibility to maintain grass verges outside your house. A few residents have volunteered to cut verges on their roads. If you want to help, contact us. The payment this year will remain at €30 per household and road reps will start collecting it after Easter. If you can afford to pay the €30 in one payment it would be appreciated, but we will accept instalments. These funds are vital for grass cutting. The Council do NOT cut the grass. If you have just moved into our estate, you are very welcome and we hope you will support us. If you are renting, please forward this to your landlord.

We urgently need road reps (helping us with funds collections) for Oak Crescent, Elm Drive, and Cedar Vale. Without the help of the road reps we can't continue our work so please continue to support.

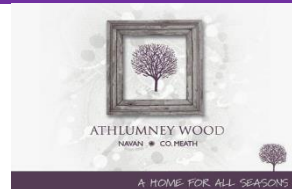
Please stop parking on the grass verge outside your homes and on the junctions in front of the STOP signs. And please stop making shorts cuts via verges from your cul de sac.
